



“People in Need: Digital teaching units enforcing European citizenship”

A proposito del progetto

Europe is facing many problems such as millions of refugees or people who are being marginalized from society because of poverty, loneliness, mental disorder and physical handicaps. In our project we create digital teaching units to make students aware of these “People in Need”.

The three units "Refugees in our Country", "Dealing with Handicaps" and "Making a Difference in our local Community" will be filled with different perspectives from Italy (I. I. S. S. Presta-Columella in Lecce), Spain (Carmen Laffon, San Jose de la Rinconada in Sevilla) and Germany (Gymnasium Buxtehude Süd in Buxtehude), so that all students can learn that helpfulness, tolerance, empathy and responsibility are international values that should be practiced by all European citizens of a united Europe. Additionally, skills as speaking, listening and reading will be applied to reach this aim. The digital teaching units in a digital magazine called "CooPEERation" should be used for further education.

Obiettivi

Through speaking, listening and reading skills students should learn that helpfulness, tolerance, empathy and responsibility are international values that should be practiced by all European citizens of a united Europe.

Procedura di lavoro

Five meetings (in total) in Italy, Spain and Germany + extracurricular activities for students to prepare the meetings. Material and work in progress will be shared via eTwinning.
